## Frequently Asked Questions



### What is the Azuga OBD-II device?

The Azuga OBD-II device is a plug-and-play telematics unit that captures vehicle data for fleet management and driver behavior insights.



### What comes in the box?

Depending on your order, you may receive the OBD-II device, an extension cable, and a Y-cable (use the Y-cable only if the diagnostic port is occupied by another device).

### Where is the diagnostic port located?

It is typically located underneath the steering wheel and may be exposed or behind a panel.

### Do I need to turn off the vehicle before installing?

Yes, always turn off the vehicle before installing the device.

### How do I install the device?

1. Note the serial number.
2. Locate the port.
3. Plug in the device.
4. Look for a green flash for confirmation.

### How do I connect the two devices?

Only do this if another device is plugged into the diagnostic port. Use the Y-cable to connect both the Azuga device and another device to the same diagnostic port.

### What does a green flashing light mean?

A green LED flashing for five seconds indicates a successful installation.

### What does a red flashing light mean?

A red LED indicates the installation was unsuccessful. Reinstall and contact support if needed.

### How do I set up the device in Azuga?

Use the mobile app or web portal to assign the device to the correct vehicle.

### Will this affect my premium?

Not at this time. If you continue with the program, there may be a discount on your premium the following year.

### Is this mandated for the church to keep our auto insurance?

No, this is a voluntary program; we are providing this tool to enhance your vehicle safety.
